


As you flip through these pages, you'll see how God is doing big things in and through us, together. Because of your generosity, you are part of each of these stories.



CHASE OAKS' GLOBAL STRATEGY





GLOBAL PARTNERS

- 1** **ORPHAN OUTREACH**, an organization that seeks to restore hope for orphaned and vulnerable children so that each child will experience God's love and know Jesus as Savior
- 2** **GIFT OF DIGNITY/CASA HOGAR ELIM ORPHANAGE**, an organization that aims to break the cycle of poverty for the underprivileged and orphaned child so that they can experience restoration to a life of purpose and fulfill their God-given potential
- 3** **BRIGHT HOPE WORLD**, an organization that helps thousands of the world's poorest families in the poorest communities, breaks the cycle of poverty so they can have hope for today, tomorrow, and eternity

La Paz, Honduras

An estimated 170,000 Honduran children are orphans, with nearly 21,000 new cases of children in crisis each year. Chase Oaks partners with Orphan Outreach for two projects: **NiCo** (Niños en Comunidad, a program providing children with tutoring, mentoring, nutritious meals, counseling, therapy, and Bible study) and the **FOSTER CARE INITIATIVE** with the Honduran government.



Chase Oaks has been supporting Orphan Outreach's NiCo efforts in La Paz, Honduras since 2020. Most of these students are trauma survivors; program staff and volunteers work with these children 2-3 times a week to help those who are at risk of falling behind.

Orphan Outreach operates an orphanage near San Pedro Sula, Honduras that can house up to 20 children. Their motto ("**Orphans don't need orphanages; they need families**") supports their goal to connect each orphan in their care to a loving family within 2 years.



Nuevo Laredo, Mexico

Chase Oaks partners with Gift of Dignity in Casa Hogar Elim, a home to **80+ CHILDREN** ranging from infancy to 24 years of age. Their goal is to enable each child to fulfill their God-given potential through three main areas: the Learning Center, vocational skills, and strategic spiritual development.

The teachers and volunteers who serve these children help to create lots of bright, happy smiles.





Cairo, Egypt

Chase Oaks partners with Bright Hope World in four key areas: small loan empowerment to **300+ FAMILIES** within traditionally poor Christian communities; a vocational training center where **50 INDIVIDUALS** learn trades each month; a ministry to **HUNDREDS OF REFUGEE FAMILIES**; and an addiction center where **16 MEN** are currently receiving help and hope as they combat their addictions.



This vehicle is known as a Tuk-Tuk in many countries. This man received a loan that enabled him to purchase his own vehicle, which enables him to earn a steady income by taxiing people around Cairo.



Several members of this Syrian refugee's family had significant health issues. The Refugee Ministry helped her cover medication costs and education expenses for the entire family.

Nairobi, Kenya

The Mathare Valley Slum near Nairobi is home to the poorest of the poor with some of the worst living conditions in the world. Chase Oaks supports the scholarships of **100 PRIMARY SCHOOL STUDENTS** and **15 SECONDARY STUDENTS** at Mathare Community Outreach Christian School. We also partner with the Moriah School of Discipleship, a six-month program for high school graduates that helps students get out of the dangerous conditions of the Mathare Valley during the critical transition from grade 12 to higher education. Last year, the program had **25 GRADUATES**.

Mbale, Uganda

The **CHOSEN GENERATION SCHOOL** is located in the small fishing village of Mbale. When Chase Oaks' partnership first began, the school met in a dilapidated open-air building. Now, they have a permanent structure with four classrooms and **8 TEACHERS**. We've helped provide teacher salaries, uniforms and books for the children, and education sponsorships, along with digging a well and building latrines within the village. As a result, **138 CHILDREN** are receiving an education. We also support a Children's Pastor who works with the children and families in the village.



At the Chosen Generation School, 138 children are receiving education through Chase Oaks funding.



This school gives its leaders a pathway to minister to families of the poor in the village.

Some trips include significant construction projects, depending on the needs.

Niños en Comunidad in La Paz, Honduras

In partnership with Orphan Outreach, Chase Oaks Church is funding two programs in La Paz: the Early Childhood Education Center and NiCo. These two ministries work directly with the public school in La Paz to identify children who are struggling in school. Chase Oaks teams work alongside the teachers, bringing biblical lessons, crafts, a carnival, games, and home visits with the parents and families of the children in the programs.
